Commission Will Follow Governor’s Latest Furlough Plan

SACRAMENTO – Governor Schwarzenegger issued Executive Order S-13-09 on July 1, 2009 that furloughs state employees and closes state offices for three days a month through June 2010. The Commission is currently following the two-days-per-month self-directed furlough plan and will adopt the new plan beginning July 10, 2009.

Based on information received from the Department of Personnel Administration, after July the Commission office will be closed the first, second and third Friday of each month with one exception in January 2010. Provided below is a schedule of planned closures for your convenience. Please note that this information is subject to change.
