

## Transition Plan and Individualized Induction Plan

*The Individualized Teacher Preparation Plan (ITPP) has been part of the requirements for the holder of a Level I Education Specialist Credential since 1997.*

*The Transition Plan and the Individualized Induction Plan (IIP) were added in regulations effective June 26, 2010 for the Preliminary Education Specialist Credential. Holders of Level I Education Specialist Credentials who choose to earn a clear credential through an induction program must work with their employing agency and program sponsor to complete an IIP.*
