

Authorization Statements for the Added Authorization in Special Education (AASE)

Autism Spectrum Disorders: The autism spectrum disorders added authorization authorizes the holder to conduct assessments, provide instruction, and special education related services to individuals with a primary disability of autism across the continuum of special education program options at the grade and age levels authorized by the prerequisite credential.

Deaf-Blind: The deaf-blind added authorization authorizes the holder to conduct assessments, provide instruction, and special education related services to individuals with a primary disability of deaf-blind across the continuum of special education program options at the grade and age levels authorized by the prerequisite credential.

Emotional Disturbance: The emotional disturbance added authorization authorizes the holder to conduct assessments, provide instruction, and special education related services to individuals with a primary disability of emotional service across the continuum of special education program options at the grade and age levels authorized by the prerequisite credential.

Other Health Impairment: The other health impairment added authorization authorizes the holder to conduct assessments, provide instruction, and special education related services to individuals with a primary disability of other health impairment across the continuum of special education program options at the grade and age levels authorized by the prerequisite credential.

Orthopedic Impairment: The orthopedic impairment added authorization authorizes the holder to conduct assessments, provide instruction, and special education related services to individuals with a primary disability of orthopedic impairment across the continuum of special education program options at the grade and age levels authorized by the prerequisite credential.

Traumatic Brain Injury: The traumatic brain injury added authorization authorizes the holder to conduct assessments, provide instruction, and special education related services to individuals with a primary disability of traumatic brain injury across the continuum of special education program options at the grade and age levels authorized by the prerequisite credential.
