



EMERGENCY DESIGNATED SUBJECTS VOCATIONAL EDUCATION 30-Day Substitute Teaching Permit

The Emergency Designated Subjects Vocational Education Permit for 30-Day Substitute Teaching Service authorizes the holder to serve as a substitute in any classroom in any county in which the permit is registered provided the employing agency has a completed Statement of Need. Such substitute teaching shall be part of a program of technical, trade, or vocational education. However, the holder shall not serve as a substitute for more than 30 days for any one teacher during the school year.

Requirements for Initial Issuance

Applicants must satisfy **all** of the following requirements:

1. **One** of the following requirements must be satisfied:
 - a. Possess a high school diploma
 - b. Possess a diploma based on passage of the GED Test
 - c. Possess the foreign equivalent of a high school diploma
2. Verification by employer(s) of five years of work experience directly related to a subject listed below (48 semester units or 72 quarter units of postsecondary vocational training, related to that vocational education subject and verified by official transcript, may be substituted for a maximum of two of the five years of work experience. This substitution may be made on a pro rata basis up to the two-year maximum. Teaching experience is not applicable to this requirement.)
3. Completed application ([form 41-4 \[pdf\]](#)), and, if not previously submitted to the Commission, a completed LiveScan receipt ([form 41-LS \[pdf\]](#))
4. Application [processing fee \[pdf\]](#)

Requirements for Reissuance

1. Submit a completed application ([form 41-REN](#)) and the appropriate fee directly to the Commission or your employer for each reissuance (each reissuance is valid for **one year**)

Note: Effective January 1, 2007, holders of the Emergency Designated Subjects Vocational Education 30-Day Substitute Permit are no longer required to complete professional growth activities, regardless of the issuance date of your credential or the renewal requirements listed on your document.
