




## Teaching Credentials Issued to Teachers who were Trained in Other Countries October 2010

In 2008-09 about four hundred initial teaching credentials were issued to teachers who were trained in other countries. Another four hundred teachers who were trained in other countries renewed their teaching credentials. Among the initial issuance, more than half (55 percent) were issued in single subject, more than one-fourth in multiple subject (26 percent) and slightly less than one-fifth in education specialist (19 percent) credentials.

Among the single subjects issued in 2008-09, mathematics and sciences accounted for 25 percent (13 percent and 12 percent, respectively). English and Foreign language credentials accounted for another 20 percent (14 percent and 6 percent, respectively). Single subjects in Social Science, Physical Education, Music, Home Economics, Art, Agriculture, Business, Industrial and Technology Education accounted for the remaining 11 percent.

Among the education specialist credentials issued, most of the issues were issued in the areas of Mild/Moderate Disabilities (15 percent) and the rest (4 percent) in Moderate/Severe disabilities, Early Childhood Special Education, and Deaf and Hard-of-Hearing credentials.
