




California Teachers: Prepared in States Other than California January 2013



In 2010-2011 about 2,500 California teaching credentials were issued to teachers prepared in states other than California.

More than 200 credentials were issued to teachers who were trained in Arizona and New York. These top two states accounted for one-fifth of the total credentials issued. The following 6 states — Texas, Illinois, Florida, Michigan, Massachusetts, and Pennsylvania — accounted for nearly one-third (29%), each state with more than 100 credentials. The following 8 states — Oregon, Washington, Nevada, Utah, Ohio, Colorado, Georgia, and New Jersey accounted for another one-fourth (23%) credentials to teachers trained in other states. Together these 16 states accounted for more than two-thirds (72%) of total credentials issued to teachers from other states.

The remaining one-third (28%) came from 33 different states and Washington D.C.; number ranged from 47 in Indiana to 2 in South Dakota.

It is also interesting to note that there were credentials issued to teachers from all 50 states and DC.
