




Designated Subjects CTE Teaching Credentials Issued

The *Preliminary* Designated Subjects CTE Teaching Credential authorizes the holder to teach within the industry sectors named on the credential in grades twelve and below and in classes organized primarily for adults, in career technical, trade or vocational courses. CTE Teaching Credentials are available in the following 15 *industry sectors*: Agriculture and Natural Resources; Arts, Media, and Entertainment; Building Trades and Construction; Education, Child Development, and Family Services; Energy and Utilities; Engineering and Design; Fashion and Interior Design; Finance and Business; Health Science and Medical; Hospitality, Tourism, and Recreation; Information Technology; Manufacturing and Product; Marketing, Sales, and Service; Public Service; and Transportation.

The figure below displays the number of Career Technical Education Teaching Credentials issued per the fifteen industry sectors for the academic year 2011-2012.



The highest number of CTE credentials was issued in the industry sector of Health Science and Medical Technology (17%), followed by Arts, Media, and Entertainment (13%), Information Technology (11%), and Finance and Business (11%). Together these four industry sectors accounted for more than half the CTE credentials issued in 2011-2012. Public Service (9%), Building Trades and Construction (8%), Hospitality, Tourism, and Recreation (6%), Education, Child Development, and Family Services (6%), and Transportation (4%), accounted for more than one-third of the credentials issued. The remaining credentials were issued for Marketing, Sales and Service (4%), Engineering and Design (3%), Agriculture and Natural Resources (3%), Manufacturing and Product Development (3%), Fashion and Interior Design (1%), and Energy and Utilities (1%).

Note - On November 1, 2007, the Commission ceased issuing Designated Subjects Vocational Education Teaching Credentials as an initial credential and began issuing the Designated Subjects Career Technical Education Teaching Credential.
