Overview of this Report

This report provides an update on the nomination and selection process for COA members. All nomination materials are due by March 1, 2007. Interviews will take place at the April 2007 Commission meeting and the terms of the new members of the COA will begin on July 1, 2007.

Background

As part of the revision of the accreditation system, the nomination and selection process for COA members has been revised and streamlined. The Commission discussed the selection process at the February 2007 meeting. As part of the discussion, the information below was presented:

Therefore there will be three vacancies, two K-12 and one postsecondary, to fill for the 2007-08 year. The Commission is scheduled to take action to extend the nine continuing members of the COA's terms as listed above at the April 2007 meeting.

David Pearson, will appoint two individuals, one K-12 and one postsecondary, to the nominating panel and the Co-Chairs of the COA, Dana Griggs and Lynne Cook, will appoint two individuals, one K-12 and one postsecondary, to the nominating panel. The nominating panel members serve for four years and may not be reappointed.

The nominating panel will review all nomination materials and select the individuals that the Commission will interview at the April 2007 meeting.
