Program of California Teachers of English Learners

University of LaVerne CTEL Program

In this program candidates will utilize Blackboard in order to provide candidates with timely feedback on assignments and assessments. Candidates will compile a portfolio throughout the program as evidence of competence in the knowledge, skills and abilities in the CTEL program.

Loyola Marymount University CTEL Program

This program includes coursework in Anthropological Analysis of Cultural Diversity, Theories of Second Language Acquisition, Methodology in English Language Development and Specially Designed Academic Instruction in English/Elementary or Secondary and Educational Linguistics. Each course has a signature assessment that is included in the portfolio which serves as the evidence of candidate competence for the CTEL certificate.

Recommendation about the Withdrawal of Professional Preparation Program

University of California, Berkeley

The University of California, Berkeley has submitted a letter to the Commission giving notice that they wish to discontinue the UC Berkeley CalPIP (Education Specialist Mild/Moderate) program. The decision to withdraw the program was made in Spring 2005. Current students were notified and an new were admitted in Fall 2005. The final two students completed the program in July 2007.
