Adoption of Guidance on Granting Equivalency Document

An additional scenario to be added at the end of the DRAFT report

Scenario 8: An individual has a PPS Credential or School Counseling MA would like to earn a Preliminary Administrative Services Credential. The employing district is encouraging their secondary counselors to earn Preliminary Administration Services credentials to allow them to engage in administrative responsibilities allowed under that authorization.

Through a review of transcripts, the representative from the approved preliminary administrative services program and the prospective school administrator identified specific courses such as “Laws and Ethics,” “Seminar in Assessment,” “Introduction to Educational Research and Statistics,” and/or “Current Issues in Education” that were completed for the PPS credential or School Counseling MA. Comparable courses are also required for the PASC and the approved program will grant an equivalency for the courses taken in the school counseling program. The individual will still need to complete the other components of the approved program and satisfy all credential requirements to earn the preliminary administrative services credential.
