The Butte County BTSA Induction Program has provided induction to 14 school districts since 1999. The Education Specialist Induction Program includes a specialized formative assessment process, the Northeastern California Teacher Education Collaborative – Education Specialist edition Local Assessment System (NECTEC-ES LAS). NECTEC-ES LAS is an inquiry process in Case Management. Providing Education Specialists individualized support tailored to meet their growth and development needs. With the support of a veteran teacher, Education Specialist Clear Credential candidates complete a two-year induction experience that includes meeting regularly to engage in the PTRA cycle of Plan, Teach, Reflect, Apply, while developing Individual Induction Plans.
