

Notification to COA of Late Documents February 2015

Overview

This item provides information to the COA regarding institutions that have not complied with the timelines of the Accreditation Cycle.

Staff Recommendation

This is for information only.

Background

At the August 2014 meeting the COA requested information regarding institutions that have not met the accreditation timelines, commencing with the Indigo Biennial Report Submission which was due September 15, 2014.

There are 41 institutions in the Indigo Cohort that sponsor 255 programs. All but four institutions (14 programs) submitted Biennial Reports on time. These were reported at the October COA meeting; all Indigo institutions have now submitted Biennial Reports. The submission date for Biennial Reports for the Red and Yellow cohorts was November 15, 2014. There are 35 institutions in the Red Cohort and 33 institutions in the Yellow cohort combining to sponsor 316 programs. All but 1 institution (4 programs) submitted Biennial Reports on time. Additionally, one institution (20 programs) is listed below. Although the Biennial Report was submitted on time, it was missing a significant number of program reports and did not include an institutional summary and was therefore incomplete.

The table below provides information about late Biennial Reports. Staff is contacting each of these sponsors to request the report. An extraordinary fee will be assessed because of the additional staff work to gather late documents.
