

Notification to COA of Late Documents April 2015

Overview

This item provides information to the COA regarding institutions that have not complied with the timelines of the Accreditation Cycle.

Background

At the August 2014 meeting the COA requested information regarding institutions that have not met the accreditation timelines, commencing with the Indigo Biennial Report Submission which was due September 15, 2014.

Program Assessment documents were due for the Green Cohort on December 31, 2014. There are 32 institutions. All but 4 (12 programs) were submitted on time. The four institutions listed below continue to have outstanding Program Assessment documents.

The table below provides information about late Program Assessment documents. Staff has contacted each of these sponsors to request the report. An extraordinary fee was assessed because of the additional staff work to gather late documents.
