

## Notification to COA of Late Documents August 2016

### Overview

This item provides information to the COA regarding institutions that have not complied with the timelines relevant to accreditation.

### Staff Recommendation

This is for information only.

### Background

At the August 2014 meeting the COA requested information regarding institutions that are not complying with accreditation timelines, commencing with the Indigo Biennial Report Submission which was due September 15, 2014.

[Program Sponsor Alert 15-08](#) notified institutions of the need to submit a transition plan by June 30, 2016 in response to the adoption of new standards for the Clear General Education Teaching Credential. Of the 176 active programs, all but 19 complied with the due date. Eleven (11) transition plans were submitted after June 30<sup>th</sup>; eight (8) are not yet submitted.
