The Commission for Teacher Preparation and Licensing has approved and adopted the attached emergency regulations in Title 5, California Administrative Code dealing with Emergency Instructional Permits for Teachers Employed in State Department of Education Community-Based Contract Centers on October 1, 1974.

These regulations become effective July 1, 1975 on an emergency basis only, and will be the subject of a Public Hearing at the September Commission meeting for proper adoption as Title 5 Regulations:



OF  
COMMISSION FOR TEACHER PREPARATION AND LICENSING

Notice is hereby given that the Commission for Teacher Preparation and Licensing, pursuant to the authority vested by Section 16770 of the Education Code, and to implement, interpret, or make specific Sections 16770 and 16763 of the Education Code, proposes to amend regulations in Title 5 of California Administrative Code as follows:

(1) Amend Section 17938, to read as follows:

17938. EMERGENCY INSTRUCTIONAL PERMIT. (a) APPLICATION. Each applicant for an emergency instructional permit shall comply with the procedure prescribed for application (Section 17932) and shall submit with the application verification of (1), (2) or (3):

(1) Sixty semester hours of course work, completed through an approved collegiate institution, including twelve semester hours of course work in subject fields related to early childhood education.


(2) One year of successful experience as a teacher, nonteaching aide or nonteaching assistant and thirty semester hours of course work, including twelve semester hours of course work in subject fields related to early childhood education and continued enrollment in an approved institution.

(3) Employment as a teacher in a State Department of Education community-based contract center on October 1, 1974.

Notice is also given that any person interested may present statements or arguments orally or in writing relevant to the action proposed at a hearing to be held at the Sheraton Inn, Sacramento, California, at 10:30 a.m. on the 4th day of September, 1975. The Commission for Teacher Preparation and Licensing, upon its own motion or at the instance of any interested person, may thereafter amend the above proposals substantially as above set forth without further notice.

NOTE: The Executive Secretary has determined that the above regulations will have no cost to the local government, pursuant to Section 2231, Chapter 358 of the 1973 Statute of the Revenue and Taxation Code.
