SUBJECT: Title 5 Regulations, Sections 5920.2, 5921, and 5922

The Commission for Teacher Preparation and Licensing has approved and adopted the following regulations in Title 5 of the California Administrative Code relating to 30-day substitute service, expiration of teaching or services credential, and life credentials. These regulations have also been approved by the California State Board of Education.

Adopts new subsection (a) of Section 5920.2 as follows:

(a) The applicant who holds a teaching credential requiring a baccalaureate degree and teacher preparation, including student teaching or teaching experience, may also serve as a 30-day substitute as authorized in this section.

Adopts new subsection (c) of Section 5921 as follows:

(c) A teaching or services credential shall be dated to expire on the first day of the month following the month in which it is issued for its full authorized term except when it is based on another credential with a different expiration date.

Adopts new Section 5922 as follows:

5922. Life Credentials. Teaching and Services Credentials  
(Education Code Section 13125) may be issued for life on receipt of a complete application when both of the following requirements have been met:

(a) Verification of five years of full-time school experience within the past 10 years, earned on possession of or while eligible for the credential under consideration, and

(b) Verification by the Governing Board of two years of continuous full-time employment in a California public school district while holding the clear credential under consideration.
