5504 (Old Number.) Report of Dismissal and Resignation.
The governing board shall immediately report to the
Commission for Teacher Preparation and Licensing Secretary
of the State Board the name and last known address of any
certificated employee of the district who has been dismissed,
or who has resigned or otherwise left the service of the
district, for any reason stated in law as cause for the
suspension or revocation of a credential issued by the State
Board or Commission for Teacher Preparation and Licensing,
together with all pertinent facts, including but not
necessarily limited to a transcript of the findings and
conclusions of the recommending Commission on Professional
Competence together with any evidentiary material, including
investigative reports, on which such recommendations were
based.
