SUBJECT: Institutional Workshop on AB 1250 and ACR 73

At the October meeting the Commission for Teacher Preparation and Licensing adopted Title 5 regulations for implementing Chapter 1247 of the Statutes of 1977, otherwise known as AB 1250. This statute states that all individuals receiving a clear teaching credential or an Administrative Services credential after July 1, 1979 shall have received training in the needs of, and methods of providing educational opportunities to, individuals with exceptional needs.

As was indicated to you in earlier correspondence this requirement will affect persons who will not complete and apply for the clear credential before July 1, 1979. For this reason, the Commission wants to provide you with timely and appropriate assistance in developing these offerings. Therefore, we are inviting you to participate in a workshop on January 12, 1979 at Fresno Pacific College, 1717 South Chestnut Avenue, Fresno (see attached agenda).

In addition to the AB 1250 topic, Assembly Concurrent Resolution 73 will be discussed which asks the Commission to encourage institutions preparing Multiple Subjects teachers to include in their training programs content related to child and motor development.

This will be the fourth of a series of regional workshops the Commission will be sponsoring throughout the state on these topics. Our intent is to provide more thorough and comprehensive consultant services using this approach as opposed to individual visits to each institution.
