## TITLE 5 REGULATIONS, EXAMINATION SYSTEM

80071. Examination-Standards-and-Procedures- Qualification by Examination for Issuance of Credential. ~~Examinations-to-meet-one-of-the requirements-for-a-credential-shall-be-adopted-and-passing-score-standards shall-be-established-by-the-Commission.~~ Every applicant who elects to qualify for issuance of a credential by examination shall be required to meet passing score requirements established by the Commission on academic achievement and/or proficiency examinations approved by the Commission. A list of the adopted examinations and passing scores will be made available upon request to the Commission. The standard applicable to an examination score is the standard established by the Commission for the year during which the examination is taken. Passing scores shall be processed by the Commission at the time of application for a credential requiring such examination. Scores will remain valid and may be used for certification purposes for two years following the date of the examination on which the score was achieved.

80071.1 Oral Proficiency Examinations for Single Subject Language Authorization. Every applicant for a single subject credential in French, German, or Spanish shall be required to pass an oral proficiency examination approved by the Commission in such language in addition to any examination required pursuant to Section 80071.

80071.2 Writing Proficiency Examination for Single Subject English Language Authorization. Every applicant for the single subject credential in English shall be required to pass a writing proficiency examination approved by the Commission in addition to any examination required pursuant to Section 80071.

80071.3 English Writing Proficiency Examination for Candidates Without College Recommendations. Every candidate for a basic credential who has not been recommended for such credential by a California institution of higher learning having a program approved by the Commission shall be required to pass an English writing proficiency examination approved by the Commission in addition to any examination required under Section 80071.
