TITLE 5 REGULATIONS, EMINENCE CREDENTIAL

80042. Eminence Credential. "Eminence" shall be interpreted to mean: (a) the possession of knowledge and skill in an area in which the school district wishes to offer in any of its schools; (b) distinguished superiority-as-compared-with-others in-attainments ability because of knowledge, experience, training or background, and recognition on either a national or statewide level as an authority, specialist, expert, proponent or leader in the subject or service in which the credential is sought; and (c) superior knowledge and skill, which shall be determined in comparison with the generally accepted standards and achievement in the profession in which the credential is sought.
