Section 80054. Services Credential With a Specialization in Administrative Services. A Services Credential with a Specialization in Administrative Services shall be issued initially only until the date of expiration of the valid teaching credential, or Services Credential with a Specialization in Pupil Personnel, Health, or Librarian Services, but for not more than five years.

(a) A Services Credential with a Specialization in Administrative Services shall be renewed until the date of expiration of the valid teaching credential, or Services Credential with a Specialization in Pupil Personnel, Health or Librarian Services, but for not more than five years.
