SUBJECT: Title 5 Regulations, Section 80042 -
Eminence Credential

In accordance with Commission policy, the following Title 5 Regulations are being distributed prior to a public hearing. The public hearing has been scheduled as follows:

The Commission proposes to rescind Section 80042 in Chapter 1, Title 5 of the California Administrative Code on a procedural and organizational basis, as follows:

80042. Eminence Credential. "Eminence" shall be interpreted to mean: (a) the possession of knowledge and skill in an area in which the school district wishes to offer in any of its schools; (b) distinguished superiority as compared with others in attainments; and (c) superior knowledge and skill, which shall be determined in comparison with the generally accepted standards and achievement in the profession in which the credential is sought.

If you wish to make a presentation regarding the above to the Commission, please bring 30 copies of your material for distribution to the Commissioners and staff. If you can provide your statement to the Commission office 15 days before the public hearing, sufficient copies of the material will be duplicated and distributed for Commission and staff use. We would also appreciate a call to the Commission office if you plan to make a presentation in order to schedule sufficient time on the Agenda for people who wish to address the Commission.
