SUBJECT: Designated Subjects Credentials

The purpose of this correspondence is to answer several questions which have been raised regarding Designated Subjects credentials. The questions and answers follow:

Question: Which agencies can recommend applicants for a preliminary Designated Subjects credential authorizing service in aviation ground instruction; basic military drill; or ROTC?

Answer: Because no Local Education Agency (LEA) has been approved to recommend for these credentials, the Commission staff will evaluate the application and grant or deny the preliminary credential.

Question: What agencies can recommend for the clear Designated Subjects credential authorizing service in aviation flight instruction/aviation ground instruction; basic military drill; or ROTC?

Answer: Following the completion of a personalized in-service program, an approved LEA will need to recommend the applicant for the clear credential.

Question: What agencies can recommend for the clear Designated Subjects Adult Education credential?

Answer: Title 5 Regulation Section 80041.3 authorized either the LEA or the employing school district (ESD) to recommend issuance of the clear credential. The ESD recommending for the clear credential must verify, on the appropriate Commission form, that a personalized in-service program was completed through an approved LEA.

Question: What are the requirements for the Designated Subjects teaching credential authorizing instruction in aviation flight instruction/aviation ground instruction; basic military drill; and ROTC?
