SUBJECT: FBI Fingerprint Card Processing Fee Increase

On August 1, 1990, the Department of Justice notified us that the FBI will raise their processing fee from \$20.00 to \$23.00 (see copy of the letter attached) effective with fingerprint cards received in Washington, D.C., on October 1, 1990.

The Department of Justice has said they must have the fingerprint cards by the close of business September 21, 1990, to meet that deadline. That means that all cards accompanied by the \$47.00 fingerprint card processing fee must arrive in the Commission office no later than September 17, 1990.

All applications with fingerprint cards filed after September 15, 1990, or received by the Commission after that date, must include the \$50.00 fingerprint card processing fee. If you cannot get an application to use in time and must ask an applicant for the additional \$3.00, you may have them attach a personal check for that amount.

INCREASED FBI APPLICANT FINGERPRINT FEE FOR 1990/1991 FISCAL YEAR


This letter is to advise all agencies of a rate increase for the Federal Bureau of Investigation (FBI) fingerprint identification services. Effective October 1, 1990, the applicant fingerprint fee rate will be increased from \$20 to \$23.

The fee increase is to compensate for escalating costs of providing service. This rate applies to all noncriminal licensing, certification, and employment fingerprint cards (with the exception of criminal justice employment) submitted to the FBI Identification Division (ID) through the California Department of Justice.
