The panel established by the Commission to evaluate agencies seeking approval to review foreign academic programs met on April 3, 1992. Based on the panel's findings, the Commission has given approval to the following agencies:

Those candidates wishing to be evaluated by World Education Service, must submit original, official documentation to that agency in order for the Commission to accept the evaluation. Those wishing to be evaluated by International Education Research Foundation, Inc. will need to follow the procedure outlined in their brochure.

These agencies have Commission approval to determine equivalencies of coursework and degrees completed at colleges and universities in countries other than the United States and Canada. They are private agencies and do charge service fees for which the credential candidate will be responsible. Their original evaluation letter and a photocopy of the original transcripts must accompany the credential application packet when it is submitted to the Commission. The Commission reserves judgement and has the ultimate authority to accept equivalency of coursework. The Commission staff will continue to evaluate Canadian coursework and degrees.
