RE: Approval of Title 5, California Code of Regulations
§80487(a)(1)-- Credential Fee Increase

This is to advise you that an amendment to Title 5 California Code of Regulations, section 80487(a)(1) pertaining to a credential fee increase adopted by the Commission on Teacher Credentialing on February 2, 1995, and was approved by the Office of Administrative Law on April 10, 1995. Specifically, section 80487(a)(1) raises the fee for issuance, reissuance or renewal of teaching and services credentials to seventy dollars (\$70.00).

Summary

The Commission had previously adopted an emergency regulation which increased the fee to seventy dollars (\$70.00) effective January 1, 1995. The regulation adopted at the February meeting sets the fee at \$70 until any further regulatory action by the Commission. The five (\$5.00) increase is earmarked to cover costs associated with the passage of SB 1843 (Hart) relating to credential review and discipline.
