THE COMMISSION

The Commission on Teacher Credentialing is an agency in the Executive Branch of California State Government responsible for:

- Accrediting educator credential preparation programs
- Issuing credentials and permits for service in California's public schools
- Administering credential discipline when necessary

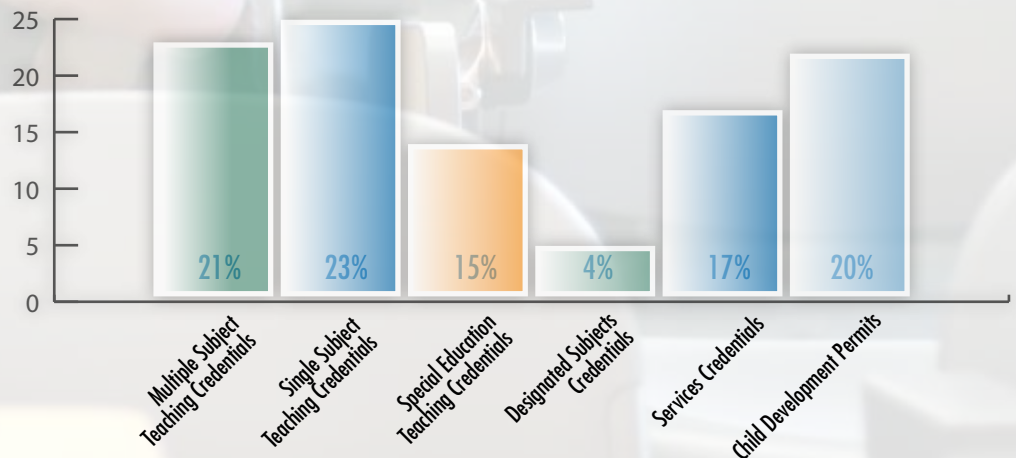
Total Number of Applications Processed – 233,101

- New applications – 38%
- Renewals – 62%

Average processing time – 81% of all applications are processed within 10 days and the remaining are processed in under 40 days.

Ensuring Educator Excellence

Teaching Credentials Include:

Multiple Subject –

- teaching a variety of subjects in a self-contained classroom

Single Subject –

- teaching a specific subject in a departmentalized classroom

Special Education –

- teaching children with disabilities

Designated Subjects Credentials Include:

Career Technical Education –

- teaching technical, trade, or vocational courses

Adult Education –

- teaching courses organized primarily for adults

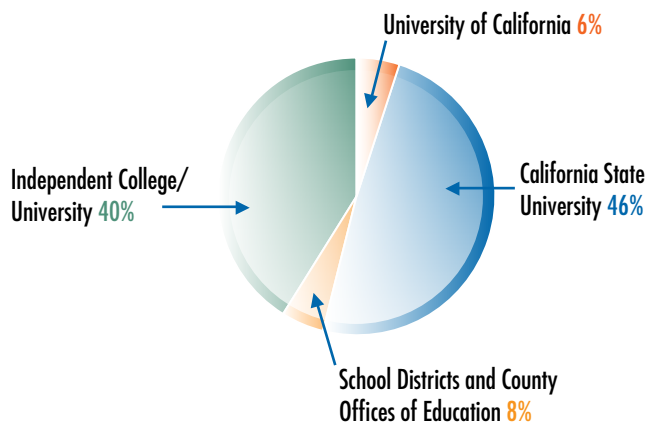
Services Credentials Include:

- school administrators
- school nurses
- school librarians
- pupil personnel services (school counselors and school psychologists)

Child Development Permits Include:

- instruction of children in preschool and before- and after-school care programs
- program supervision
