INTERVIEWS FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE COMMITTEE OF CREDENTIALS

Summary

The Executive Committee will interview, evaluate, and appoint one secondary teacher member to serve on the Committee of Credentials.

The Selection Process

Staff was notified after the November 30 - December 1, 2004 Commission meeting that the secondary teacher position on the Committee of Credentials had become vacant due to the incumbent's promotion to an administrative position, which makes him ineligible to continue to serve as a secondary teacher member. Applications were prepared and distributed. A postmark date of January 20, 2005 was set as the deadline for the submission of applications, however, the Commission hadn't received any applications by the January/February 2005 Commission meeting. Staff was directed to screen applications for the secondary member vacancy and schedule interviews for the March 10, 2005 Commission meeting. Two applications have been received.

Fiscal and Workplan Impact

Costs associated with the selection process are part of the base budget of the Division of Professional Practices. These include the costs of travel and accommodations for interviewees.
