Senate Bill 488 (Chap. 678, Stats. 2021) requires the Commission to (a) update its standards for the preparation of teacher candidates with respect to reading and literacy instruction, (b) review teacher preparation programs' progress in meeting the updated literacy standards, and (c) develop a new literacy performance assessment to replace the current Reading Instruction Competence Assessment (RICA) by 2025.
