Commission staff is seeking additional Education Specialist Early Childhood Special Education (ECSE) candidates and Education Specialist Visual Impairment (VI) candidates to meet the target number of responses in the credential area. Commission staff have been in communication with all Education Specialist Deaf and Hard of Hearing (DHH) programs and at this time, have available candidates enrolled in the pilot study.

Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Commission:

- 1. Approve candidate waiver requests from selected institutions to waive the RICA requirement for those who meet the approved passing standard of 14 points for the LPA pilot study.
- Approve candidate waiver requests from selected institutions to waive the CalTPA Cycle 2 requirement for those whose institutions using the CalTPA model and who meet the approved passing standard of 14 points for the LPA pilot study.

Next Steps

If the Commission approves the waiver requests for candidates participating in the pilot study, then ES and staff will work with the institutions and their selected candidates for the pilot, conduct an orientation with participating programs and candidates, and initiate the pilot in January 2023. If requests come in after the October 2023 Commission meeting, their waiver requests will be placed on the December 2023 Consent Calendar.
