Proposed Adoption of Revised Program Standards for the Child Welfare and Attendance Authorization

Pursuant to SB 223 (Chap. 175, Stats. 2023), local education agencies will be allowed to offer Child Welfare and Attendance (CWA) authorization preparation programs beginning January 1, 2024. Because the current CWA content is embedded in the current Pupil Personnel program

standards, it is necessary to adopt a new set of stand-alone CWA program standards in order to implement this new statute. This agenda item presents for consideration and potential adoption by the Commission proposed program standards for the Child Welfare and Attendance authorization.
