SUBJECT: Issuance of Credentials Pending Extension of the Basic Skills
Examination Deadline of March 1, 1982

The Commission for Teacher Preparation and Licensing will continue to accept applications on and after March 1, 1982. Applications, requiring the basic skills examination, will be processed in the usual manner, with the exception that the credential will not be issued until the legislation extending the date (AB 283) has been chaptered by the Secretary of State with an urgency clause.

I will notify you immediately upon hearing that AB 283 has been signed.

Colleges and universities, approved by the Commission to issue credentials requiring the basic skill examination, will not issue those credentials commencing March 1, 1982.

Employing agencies will need to check with their local county counsel regarding the interpretation of Sections 44332 (temporary county certificates) and 44830 (initial employment of certificated personnel).
