Proposed Changes in Title 5 Regulations for Single Subject

Waiver Programs, Section 80085.

In accordance with Commission policy and administrative regulations in the California Government Code, the above cited Title 5 Regulation is being distributed prior to public hearing. The public hearing to amend this regulation is scheduled as follows:

> June 2, 1983 1:30 p.m. Mansion Inn 16th and H Streets Sacramento, California

Specifically, this regulation makes the following changes:

Amends Title 5 Section 80085 to specify the information to be provided, by Institutions of Higher Education, in seeking approval of programs of Single Subject Matter Preparation as Waivers from Subject Matter Examinations. Said information to be the basis upon which the Commission on Teacher Credentialing shall make decisions as to the approval/disapproval of such requests.

Proposed Amendments to Title 5 Regulation

80085. Programs of Academic Preparation.

In accordande with the requirements of Sections 44310, 44311 and 44312 of the Education Code, the Commission shall evaluate a subject matter program submitted to it as adequate and appropriate for the purpose of waiving the respective subject matter examination, and shall grant such subject matter program waiver status upon fulfillment of the general requirements as specified in California Administrative Code Section 80085.1 and the specific requirements as specified in Section 80086, by the institutions requesting approval of such programs of academic preparation. The following information shall be provided by institutions seeking such approval, and shall be the basis upon which the Commission shall make decisions as to approval/disapproval:

- (a) A listing of courses, within the total required unit count (a minimum of 30 semester units or its equivalent quarter units), clearly identifying which of the courses constitute the 2/3 basic core designed to relate directly to those subjects "commonly taught" in the public schools.
- (b) This listing to also identify the 1/3 supplement designed to provide breadth and perspective to the basic core, and to specify whether semester units or quarter units are used.
- (c) For purposes of clarification, an institution may submit a statement for each course indicating its relationship to the subjects listed in Title 5 Regulations Section 80086.
