SUBJECT: Additional Fee Change

We have just been notified by the Department of Justice that the cost for processing a fingerprint card through their office will go up from \$16.50 to \$18.50 effective September 1, 1988. The fee for processing a fingerprint card through the Federal Bureau of Investigation will remain at \$14.00 for the next fiscal year. The filing date on the application will determine the amount of the fee to be paid: applications filed on or after September 1, 1988, must include the new fingerprint card processing fee, as well as the new fees explained in Coded Correspondence #87-8815.
