Subject: CLEP Examination in English Composition and Essay

Candidates for a Single Subject Credential in the subject of English who have not completed a subject matter waiver program in English have been required to take the NTE English examination and demonstrate writing ability by taking the CLEP English Composition With Essay.

As of September 1, 1991, the CLEP examination will no longer be required. In its place, a passing score (41 or higher) in the reading and writing sections of the CBEST will be required. If a person wishes to use a passing CLEP score it will be accepted.
