SUBJECT: DOJ Change in Dissemination Criteria for Dual Prints - Livescan: Application Type

TCC/Teacher Credentialing (Replaces Coded Correspondence 16-11)

Summary:

The Department of Justice (DOJ) has notified the Commission on Teacher Credentialing (CTC) that effective October 20, 2016, they will no longer provide any response for background checks with the (Dual) Live Scan application type: TCC/Teacher Credentialing. DOJ notified the CTC that the effective date changed to October 20, 2016 from October 24, 2016.

Key Provisions:

In an effort to ensure compliance with California statute, specifically Education Code section 44332.6, effective October 20, 2016, background checks submitted by a County Office of Education (COE) or School District (SD) for the Temporary County Certificate (TCC) applicant type will no longer result in a background check response to the Commission on Teacher Credentialing. As a result, when a COE or SD requests a background check for a TCC applicant type, the response will only be provided to the agency requesting the background check.

Important Dates:

The effective date of this change will be October 20, 2016.
