Proposed Amendments and Additions to Title 5 of the California Code of Regulations Pertaining to New Education Specialist Credentials Final Statement of Reasons

Updated Informative Digest

After review by the Office of Administrative Law, the Commission voluntarily withdrew the file to make additional changes to the text and provide additional justification and documents relied upon for the rulemaking file via a 15-day notice. Additionally, the 15-day notice detailed the reasoning for taking out the original standards and Teaching Performance Expectations (TPEs) that were incorporated by reference and instead placing them into their own section of regulations, the reasoning for not making the originally proposed changes to sections 80070.4, 80048.9.4, 80048.9, 80048.5, and 80046.1., and the reasoning for the updates to the originally proposed text.

At the April 2022 meeting the Commission adopted the proposed revisions to the text. April Commission Agenda Item 2C (beginning on page 35) is included in the rulemaking file as a document relied upon and the draft April 2022 minutes have been included in the rulemaking file as proof of adoption.

Following adoption by the Commission, a 15-day notice detailing the updates to the rulemaking file was posted on April 11, 2022. The public comment period ended on April 26, 2022. A copy of the notice is included in this rulemaking file. No comments were received.

After the second 15-day notice was posted a typo was discovered in section 80048.6(b)(8) in the last sentence. The words “prior to” were unintentionally deleted from the sentence in the version of the text in the second 15-day notice. The text in the 45-day notice does contain the words “prior to” in the original underline and strikethrough version. The final text submitted in this packet has the correct wording. Additionally, a second typo was found in section 80048.10(g). The word “sections” should be singular, as only one section is referenced. This correction has been made.

Problem Statement

There is no change to the public problem information since the original submission of the Initial Statement of Reasons.

Statement of Purpose

There is no change to the original purpose of the proposed action since the original submission of the Initial Statement of Reasons except for the reasoning for placing the standards and TPEs into their own sections.

Consideration of Alternatives

Since the original rulemaking was initiated, no alternatives were proposed by any party or the Commission during the rulemaking proceeding; therefore, the Commission has determined that there is no alternative that would be 1) more effective, 2) as effective and less burdensome, or

3) more cost effective and equally as effective as the proposed regulations.

Mandated Costs

These proposed regulations will not impose a mandate on local agencies or school districts.

Updated Tally of Responses

The Commission did not receive written responses to the public announcement during the initial 45-day comment period or during the two 15-day comment periods.
