SUBJECT: Reunification of Certification Staff

The Certification Division has experienced cut backs in staffing over the last several years. Due to these changes, modifications have been made to some services provided by the Certification Division. To improve our application processing and services to our stakeholders, the Certification staff will be moving from their current four teams specializing in processing specific types of certification to one team on March 1.

Most of the changes that will occur in the reunification will be seamless and will not affect our stakeholders. One change that will be noticed is the phones. Effective March 1, there will be only one option available to speak to a Certification Officer rather than four. To speak to a Certification Officer on March 1, the caller can push #6 and then #1 and the caller will be connected to a Certification Officer. There will be four Certification staff on the telephones to respond to calls. There is no change in the telephone hours.
