SUBJECT: Certificate of Clearance Fee

Coded Correspondence 06-0013, distributed September 21, 2006, discussed the Commission's current practice of allowing applicants to apply the Certificate of Clearance (C of C) fee toward <u>any</u> credential, certificate, or permit. This practice will be changed for C of C applications received on or after 1/1/2007.

Title 5 section 80028(b) states that the Certificate of Clearance fee shall apply toward the issuance of an **initial** credential (based on completion of a credential program). For C of C's with an issuance date on or after 1/01/07, applicants must use their C of C fee only towards the issuance of their **initial** credential.

The Commission is encouraging recommending agencies to carefully check their applicant files for valid C of C fees prior to applying online for an individual's first recommended document. When an applicant does not use the C of C fee for the initial credential application, the fee is deemed earned upon receipt and <u>will not be refunded</u>, per Title 5 section 80487(b).

Individuals that were issued C of C's prior to 1/1/2007, and have not used their fee will need to use the fee toward an issuance or renewal of their **next** teaching or service credential or permit.

The Commission's Certification staff will continue to process applications with submission dates prior to 1/1/2007, under current application procedures.
