SUBJECT: 2015 Spring Credential Webcast

The Commission on Teacher Credentialing invites all stakeholders interested in the activities of the Commission to participate in the 2015 Spring Credential Webcast (SCW). This webcast will be a live presentation with an opportunity to submit questions to be answered live as time permits.
