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What is a Self-Contained Setting?

The same group of students are taught multiple subjects by one educator throughout the day.



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Documents that Authorize Teaching in a Self-Contained Classroom Setting

Currently Issued Documents:

- •Multiple Subject Teaching Credential (TC2)
 Including University TC2(IN) and District Intern TC10(ML)
- •General Education Limited Assignment Permit (TLA2)
- Short-Term Staff Permit (TC13)
- Provisional Internship Permit (TC14)

Multiple Subject Teaching Credential Base Authorization Allows instruction in self-contained classroom in grades 12 and below, including preschool, and classes organized for adults - Team Teaching - Regrouping - Core Settings (grades 5-8) - Departmentalized Reading - Substitute for an unlimited amount of time in self-contained classroom

Variations of the Multiple Subject authorization:

- Regrouping
- Team Teaching
- •Middle School Core Setting

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Regrouping

When two or more teachers each teach all subjects in a self-contained classroom, but group their students for one or more of those subjects. Students may be grouped by their learning level.

Teacher A's Selfcontained **Grade Level or Remedial Science** Class Teacher B's Selfcontained **Advanced Science** Class

Team Teaching Team teaching occurs when two teachers divide their self-contained classroom instruction based on each teacher's strengths in a specific subject area(s). For example, one teacher might provide instruction in English language arts to both classes (at different times) Mr. Fitzgerald (Group A) Mrs. Edison (Group B) Subject 1: Homeroom Subject 1: Homeroom Subject 2: English Subject 2: Science Subject 3: English (Group B) Subject 3: Science (Group A) Subject 4: Lunch Subject 4: Lunch Subject 5: Prep Subject 5: Social Science Subject 6: Social Science Subject 6: Math Subject 7: Math Subject 7: Prep

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A core setting is one in which a teacher is assigned on the basis of a credential that authorizes service in a self-contained classroom and: 1. Teaches two or more subjects to the same group of students in the same day, and; 2. The student population for the class(es) remains substantially the same.

Middle School Core Setting: Hanging Period

- Same subject already being taught in core assignment
- Same grade level as core assignment
- •Cannot constitute more than half of the teacher's total assignment

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What courses can be "cored"?

- •Can be Academic or Elective
- ■Must be grade 5-8
- Not authorized to be part of a core setting:
- Departmentalized ELD
- Career Technical Education (CTE) courses







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Transitional Kindergarten (TK) First year of a 2 year kindergarten program Require a Multiple Subject credential Currently issued documents that authorize teaching TK: Full Multiple Subject Credential, University Intern, District Intern, GELAP, STSP, PIP

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Transitional Kindergarten (TK)

EC section 48000(g) requires credentialed teachers who are first assigned to a TK classroom after July 1, 2015 to have one of the following by August 1, 2021:

- **2**4+ units in early childhood education, or childhood development, or both
- ■Professional experience in a classroom setting with preschool age children comparable to the 24 units of education described in bullet 1
- Child Development Teacher Permit

A Single Subject document issued by the Commission authorizes the holder to teach Transitional Kindergarten.

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
