

## Update on Accreditation Activities for Spring 2018 February 2018

### Overview of this Report

The new accreditation system requires that the Commission staff, members of the Board of Institutional Review, and institutions be engaged in accreditation activities throughout a 7 year cycle. This report presents to the COA a summary of the activities taking place during Spring 2018.

### Background

The Commission’s accreditation system is a complex web of activities to ensure that programs are adhering to the state adopted educator preparation standards and offering high quality programs to ensure well prepared educators. The 7 year cycle includes the following components:

- Year 1 – Submission and Review of Preconditions

- Year 2 – Annual Data submission
- Year 3 – Annual Data submission
- Year 4 – Submission and Review of Preconditions  
Annual Data Submission
- Year 5 – Submission and Review of Common Standards  
Submission and Review of Program Standards

- Year 6 – Accreditation Site Visit  
Annual Data Submission
- Year 7 – Follow Up (address stipulations and/or concerns)
