Staff began implementing a program completer survey several years ago. Only this past year were the response rates high enough to allow the use the results in the accreditation system. This agenda item includes a presentation by staff of some of the findings of the program completer surveys and a demonstration of some of the ways that the Commission has been experimenting with visualization of the data.
