Staff discussed how the aspects of the Program Review process may be implemented for the IPR process. Staff also discussed how aspects from the Program Review process can be beneficial to reviewers during the IPR process in better understanding a proposed program's design, pathways, and delivery models. Additional components include providing specific information on faculty qualifications, fieldwork and clinical practice, and course sequence.
