

Discussion of the 7th Year Follow-up Report Submitted by California State University, Los Angeles February 2022

Overview

This item provides information on the 7th Year Follow-up Report for California State University, Los Angeles.

Recommendation

No action is required beyond accepting the report from California State University, Los Angeles, as there were no stipulations.

Background

California State University, Los Angeles (Cal State LA) hosted an accreditation visit on November 15-18, 2020. The COA granted a status of **Accreditation** to the institution. The full team report, [Cal State LA, 2020, Site Visit Report](#), is available.

As a part of the accreditation decision, the COA also required that the institution provide a 7th Year Report [Cal State LA 7th Year Report](#). As identified below, the topics that were to be addressed in the 7th year report are the following:

1. That in the Teacher Induction and Education Specialist: Visual Impairment programs all district-employed supervisors are consistently trained in supervision, oriented to the supervisory role, evaluated, and recognized.
2. That in the Education Specialist: Visual Impairment program information and personnel are consistently accessible to guide each candidate's attainment of program requirements and support candidates who need assistance.
3. That in the Teacher Induction program the ILP includes defined and measurable outcomes for the candidate and induction leaders provide formative feedback to mentors on their work, including establishment of collaborative relationships.

The Cal State LA report provides information on steps taken by the institution to address the issues identified above.
