Staff Recommendation

That after discussion with the program sponsors and after review of the BIR review of the program as well as documentation from the institution submitting the proposal, the Committee on Accreditation grants initial accreditation for the following programs.

Preliminary Multiple Subject Intern

Los Angeles Pacific University

Los Angeles Pacific University (LAPU) is an institution in Stage V of the Initial Institutional Approval (IIA) process that currently operates a traditional Preliminary Multiple Subject credential program. LAPU is proposing to add an intern pathway for its Multiple Subject credential program. Rather than completing traditional student teaching under the guidance of a master teacher, intern candidates will instead be a teacher of record in their own, full-time classroom. Intern candidates will complete all aspects of the currently approved Multiple Subject credential program with the only difference being that the internship will replace student teaching in the course sequence.
