Discussion of the 7th Year Report from Burbank Unified School District June 2022

Overview

This report is a follow up to the February 2021 accreditation visit to Burbank Unified School District, providing a detailed explanation of the actions the program has taken to address Common Standard 3 which was met with concerns.

Background

A virtual visit was held from February 22th to 24th, 2021. The full report of that visit is available here: <u>Burbank Unified School District Accreditation Report 2021.</u> The COA assigned the status of *Accreditation with a 7th year Report* to the institution, asking for evidence of actions taken on the following items:

- 1. Adjustments to its program design to better align to the 2016 Induction standards, including the reliance of the ILP as the sole documentation of teacher growth.
- 2. The design and implementation of a system that systematically recognizes mentors and their work.

7th Year Report

In early June 2022, one year from the COA's action on the site visit report, the program submitted their 7th year report addressing the issues outlined above. In each instance, the program now offers multiple pathways to demonstrate their alignment with Common Standard 3 that was found to be Met with Concerns. Their report can be read in its entirety here.
