

Discussion of Institutions Not In Compliance with Accreditation Timelines February 2023

Overview

This item provides information to the COA regarding institutions that have not complied with the timelines of the accreditation cycle. Specifically, this item covers a Common Standards submissions, Annual Accreditation Fees, Annual Data Submission, Preconditions and Program Review submissions.

Staff Recommendation

This is an action/information item.

Background

At the August 2014 meeting the COA requested information regarding institutions that are not complying with accreditation timelines. Since that time staff has been providing the COA with this information.

Program Review:

Program Review documentation was due on October 15, 2022 from institutions in the Blue Cohort. The Blue cohort is comprised of 33 institutions who are participating in the Program Review process with a total of 89 programs to be reviewed. There are no late program review documents to report.

At the last COA meeting, staff reported that the following institutions were still in the process of providing transition information for their Pupil Personnel Services programs, that were required to transition to the new standards by July 1, 2022.

- CSU Los Angeles School Psychology
- CSU Sacramento School Counseling
- CSU Sacramento School Social Work
- University of LaVerne School Counseling
- CSU East Bay School Psychology
- National University School Counseling and School Psychology

Since the October COA meeting, staff has received, reviewed, and approved transition plans from all of the programs listed above with the exception of National University. National University has provided the Commission with information about all Performance Expectations for PPS School Counseling and School Psychology indicating which courses these programs are introduced, practiced and assessed. At this time, National has submitted course syllabi for some, but not all of their courses. National University has agreed to provide the remaining syllabi in January 2023.
