

Report of the Required 7th Year Report by Hebrew Union College

Overview

Background

Summary of Actions taken by Hebrew Union College

Topics to Address	HUC Summary of Actions
Common Standard 4 Rationale – Evidence gathered from documents and interviews suggests that the unit collects and uses some data to engage in improvement and make appropriate modifications at both the unit and program level. However, there was inconsistent evidence to support a comprehensive continuous improvement process. In addition, while both the unit and its programs regularly collect data, and some of that data is analyzed and used to improve programs and their services, evidence was inconsistent that data are systematically used to improve programs and their services.	HUC has addressed this topic in the following ways: Since the CTC site visit in March 2022, the HUC School of Education Leadership team have met regularly to discuss specific assessments, evaluations, and survey results to develop a timeline and process for strategic yearly continuous improvement. The unit is now collecting data at three points during the year, surveying each stakeholder group (students, mentors, clinical educators and site school administrators), and scheduling time during their regular leadership team meetings to discuss and analyze results and make programmatic
