It is the number of units required in order for newly enrolled candidates to complete all program requirements and be recommended for the credential or authorization. If the program does not operate in a unit-based environment, enter 0 for this question.
3	In months, what is the expected length of the program if the candidate is enrolled full-time?	The definition for full-time is at the discretion of the institution and the intent of the question is to understand how long, in months, it is expected to take for candidates to finish the program when enrolled full time. The Commission is interested in understanding how long, in months, it is expected to take for candidates to finish the program when enrolled on a full- time basis.
4	In months, what is the expected length of the program if the candidate is enrolled part-time?	The definition for part-time is at the discretion of the institution and the intent of the question is to understand how long, in months, it is expected to take for candidates to finish the program when enrolled on a part-time basis.
